

Employers may receive credit for attending the trainings listed below. Trainings not listed will require pre-approval from the LSI Program Office.

Examples of approved formal training may include:

- Washington Logging Safety Conference
- L&I Governor's Safety and Health Conference
- Master Logger's Safety Training
- L&I Safety Training Workshop
- LSI Landowner Safety Day or Trainings
- Oregon Governor's Occupational Safety & Health Conference
- Western Pulp, Paper, & Forest Products Safety and Health Conference
- Intermountain Logging Conference
- Pacific Logging Congress
- Associated Oregon Loggers Annual Statewide Safety Conference

b. Employers must complete four LSI quarterly trainings per year.

LSI provided training materials can be found on the LSI training library website. The employer, or designee, and crew members engaged in manual logging operations must complete a minimum of four LSI safety quarterly trainings.

The trainings may be conducted by the employer, designee, crew members, or a third party and can be done as part of regular safety meetings.

LSI employers must document that the training occurred on the training roster form that the LSI Program has provided. DOSH will assess training completions at the annual comprehensive consultation.
